Fold your paper plate in half and then cut down the center. Then take your two pieces and fold each of them in half. Cut the flat corner in a rounded shape.

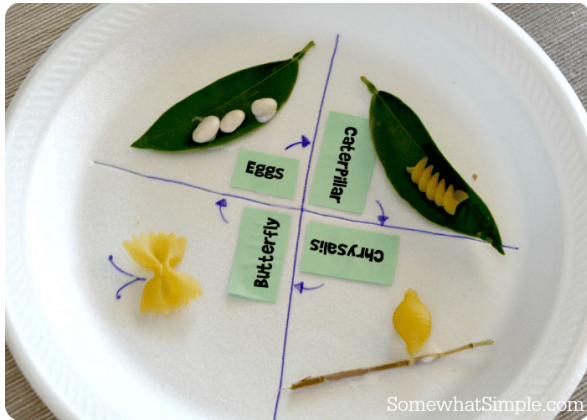
Now paint your butterfly wings! Watercolors are fun because you can blend the colors together, but any type of paint would work.

While your wings dry put together the body of your butterfly. Hot glue your pom poms to the wooden stick.

We used half of a pipe cleaner and then folded it in half and curled the ends. Hot glue your antennae to the back of the stick.

Add your googly eyes. The last thing you need to do is to glue your body to the dry wings.
